### **SELECTED CASES**

***R v Morgan* (District Court of NSW, O'Connor A-DCJ, 7 November 2017)**

Unled – appeared for the offender on sentence in respect of an offence of aggravated break and enter dwelling-house with intent to commit serious indictable offence.

***R v Maitland* (District Court of NSW, Zahra DCJ, 4-8; 11-15; 18-22; 25 September 2017)**

Unled – appeared for the accused at a trial of four charges of offences contrary to s. 178BB of the *Crimes Act 1900* (NSW); indictment permanently stayed as an abuse of process.

***Dickens v State of New South Wales & Ors* [2017] NSWSC 1173**

Unled – appeared for the first defendant on a summary dismissal/strike out application in respect of an action brought by the plaintiff for intentionally inflicted psychiatric injury.
